ALLOCATION GUIDELINES

Like us, you will want your employees to arrive for work in a clean, presentable uniform every day. With this in mind, you should ensure each employee is provided with an appropriate number of garments to ensure they can wash and dry their uniforms regularly. The correct allocation will vary depending on the style being worn, so please see the information below for guidance.

TOTAL WORKING DAYS = 233 (EXAMPLE UK)

365 days per year
20 days holiday
8 days bank holiday
104 weekend days

	JACKETS, WAISTCOATS, & COATS	TROUSERS, SKIRTS & DRESSES	KNITWEAR & FLEECES	POLOS, SHIRTS & BLOUSES
FULL TIME	2	3	3	5
PART TIME	2	2	2	3

The same garments should not be worn on consecutive days.

AFTERCARE GUIDELINES

Below is an approximate guide for the number of washes / dry cleans your garments require per year.

2 JACKETS maximum 10 washes / 10 dry cleans

2 WAISTCOATS maximum 10 washes / 10 dry cleans

Please note our Tweed Jackets and Waistcoats are dry clean only.

3 TROUSERS maximum 20 washes

3 SKIRTS maximum 20 washes

3 DRESSES maximum 20 washes

3 KNITWEAR & FLEECES maximum 20 washes

5 POLOS maximum 45 washes

5 SHIRTS & BLOUSES maximum 45 washes
